Website Terms of Use & Privacy Notice

By creating a user account on the Neil Cartwright Music website, you confirm that you have read and agree to these Terms of Use and Privacy Notice.

For the purposes of these Terms:

- **“Music”** refers to all audio content made available on the Neil Cartwright Music website.
- **“User”** refers to any person who registers for or uses an account on the website.

1. Account Registration

Registration is available to users worldwide.

By registering for an account, you confirm that:

- the information you provide is accurate and complete;
- you are authorised to enter into this agreement;
- you will keep your login details secure;
- you will not share your account with any other person or organisation.

Neil Cartwright Music reserves the right to suspend or remove any account where misuse is suspected.

2. Access to the Music Library

Creating an account allows users to:

- download music files in WAV format;
- create and save playlists;
- add project notes to playlists and tracks;
- contact the composer through the website.

Streaming and preview listening may be available without registration.

Downloading music from the library does **not** transfer ownership of any copyright or other intellectual property rights.

3. Licensing Requirements

All music in this library remains the property of Neil Cartwright Music and is registered with [PRS for Music](#) and the [Mechanical-Copyright Protection Society](#).

No licence to use any music is granted by downloading content from this website. All rights are reserved unless and until the appropriate licence has been obtained separately.

Before any music is used in any production, broadcast, reproduction, streaming, synchronisation, or public release, the user is solely responsible for obtaining the appropriate [MCPS Licence](#).

The user warrants and represents that they hold, or will obtain prior to any use, all necessary licences, including (but not limited to) an MCPS licence.

Any download of music constitutes a declaration by the user that they are authorised to obtain such licences and will comply with all applicable licensing requirements.

It is the user's responsibility to ensure that the correct licence is in place before publication or distribution of any project containing music from this library.

For licensing information, users should refer to the MCPS licensing process via PRS for Music.

4. Permitted Use

Music downloaded from this website may only be used in accordance with a valid licence.

Users must not:

- use any music without the appropriate licence;
- claim ownership of any music;
- resell, redistribute, or sublicense any music;
- share downloaded files with unauthorised third parties;
- use the music for unlawful, defamatory, or misleading purposes;
- use the music or website content to train artificial intelligence systems without written permission;
- alter or edit music in a way that misrepresents the composer's work without permission.

5. Intellectual Property

All music, artwork, text, branding, and website content are owned by **Neil Cartwright Music** unless otherwise stated.

All rights are reserved.

Nothing in these terms grants any ownership rights to users beyond the limited right to access the library and obtain licensed use where appropriate.

6. User Content

Where users submit information through contact forms, playlist notes, or project notes:

- the user remains responsible for the content submitted;
- submitted content must not be unlawful or infringe any third-party rights;
- Neil Cartwright Music may store such content as part of account functionality.

7. Privacy

Neil Cartwright Music collects the information necessary to operate user accounts and to protect the library:

Name

- email address
- IP address (recorded when you confirm your licensing declaration and when you download files)

Name and email address are used solely for:

- account creation;
- login authentication;
- user support;
- communication relating to the music library.

IP addresses are collected and retained for two purposes:

- a licensing audit trail — to record who confirmed their MCPS/licensing responsibility and when (see Section 10); and
- abuse prevention — to enforce download limits and detect misuse of accounts.

Our lawful basis for storing IP addresses is our legitimate interest in keeping accurate licensing records, protecting our legal rights, and safeguarding the security of the service. IP addresses recorded for abuse prevention are kept for up to 12 months and then deleted; IP addresses forming part of a licensing declaration are retained for the life of the account and for up to 6 years afterwards.

Neil Cartwright Music does not sell or share personal information with third parties.

No marketing emails will be sent unless specifically requested by the user.

Users may request deletion of their account at any time by contacting:

Upon request, account information and associated user data will be permanently removed.

8. Limitation of Responsibility

Users are solely responsible for ensuring that:

These Terms of Use and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
